INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

- 1. Discuss future education ideas.** The NCAA Division I Student-Athlete Advisory Committee discussed future educational ideas surrounding name, image and likeness. The committee discussed the following ideas: (1) One-page educational document; (2) Videos; (3) “Dos and Don’ts” on jeopardizing your eligibility (e.g., roadmap to using your name, image and likeness in the collegiate world); and (4) Provide education to student-athletes with all NIL resources. The committee discussed incorporating high profile individuals into the education plan.
- 2. Update on recommendations from NCAA Division I Student-Athlete Advisory Committee Strategic Vision and Planning Subcommittee.** The Student-Athlete Advisory Committee received an update and provided feedback on the recommendations that the subcommittee has been working on this past spring. The committee will proceed with implementation of the discussed recommendations.
- 3. Discuss full-time enrollment options for postgraduate student-athletes.** The committee received an update on full-time enrollment options for postgraduate student-athletes. The committee was supportive of allowing student-athletes to be less-than-full-time once the student-athlete has acquired their degree. The committee noted the financial implication requiring a student-athlete to be full-time if not receiving financial aid assistance. The committee was supportive of exploring alternative experience ideas (e.g., internship), not limiting student-athletes to a credit hour requirement.
- 4. Approval of the NCAA Division I Student-Athlete Advisory Committee April 8 meeting report.** The committee reviewed and approved the report from its April 8 meeting.
