

REPORT OF THE NCAA DIVISION I STUDENT-ATHLETE EXPERIENCE COMMITTEE APRIL 12, 2021, VIDEOCONFERENCE

<u>ACTION ITEMS</u>.

- 1. Legislative items.
 - None.
- 2. Nonlegislative items.
 - Virtual, nonphysical countable activities waiver sport other than basketball and football. The NCAA Division I Student-Athlete Experience Committee recommended an extension of the current virtual, nonphysical countable athletically related activities blanket waiver until the first day of classes for the institution's 2021 fall term or the start of the preseason practice period, whichever is earlier. The committee supports extending the blanket waiver, in sports other than basketball and football, to permit an institution to require up to eight hours per week of virtual, nonphysical countable athletically related activities (e.g., film review, team meetings, chalk talk) and for each sport to require an institution to provide student-athletes at least one day off per week (rather than the legislated two days outside the season). The committee noted the circumstances during summer 2021 are substantially similar to summer 2020; specifically, the committee noted the uncertainty surrounding access to on-campus resources and course offerings during summer 2021.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

- 1. **COVID-19 continuation of delayed-enrollment policy.** The Student-Athlete Experience Committee continued its discussion regarding the potential extension of the 2020-21 COVID-19 delayed-enrollment policy to 2021-22. The committee did not support an extension of the 2020-21 COVID-19 delayed-enrollment policy, noting the importance of returning to the normal application of the delayed-enrollment legislation. The committee indicated its preference that NCAA staff handle delayed-enrollment waivers during the 2021-22 academic year on a case-by-case basis.
- 2. Extension of COVID-19 financial aid exemptions waiver. The committee continued its discussion regarding a waiver request from the Southeastern Conference that would extend, for one year, the NCAA Division I Council's March 30, 2020, action to permit institutions to exempt the athletics aid of a student-athlete during the student-athlete's final season of eligibility while enrolled at the same institution from which the student-athlete received a COVID-19 season-of-competition or extension-of-eligibility waiver. The committee did not support extending the blanket waiver for one year, noting the importance of returning to the normal application of the financial aid legislation. However, the committee noted that the amended waiver request is more narrowly tailored to those academic terms directly affected by the COVID-19 pandemic, which the committee preferred over the broader request originally recommended by the Southeastern Conference.
