



**REPORT OF THE
NCAA DIVISION I STUDENT-ATHLETE EXPERIENCE COMMITTEE
DECEMBER 19, 2022, VIDEOCONFERENCE**

ACTION ITEMS.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **NCAA Division I Student-Athlete Advisory Committee update.** The NCAA Division I Student-Athlete Advisory Committee provided an update regarding its athletics eligibility model.
2. **USA Baseball/Major League Baseball Draft Combine blanket waiver request.** The Student-Athlete Experience Committee (SAEC) reviewed a blanket waiver request from USA Baseball to extend relief permitting student-athletes to participate in the 2023 USA Baseball/MLB Draft Combine. The SAEC indicated support of the blanket waiver request to permit student-athlete participation in the 2023 USA Baseball/MLB Draft Combine for a period that exceeds 48 hours. Further, the SAEC also indicated support for such participation to not be considered the student-athlete's one tryout with a professional sports organization currently permitted by the legislation after initial full-time enrollment. The SAEC noted that the waiver request would provide baseball with similar relief that exists legislatively in basketball and ice hockey, and the SAEC supports a legislative change rather than continued waiver relief for 2024.
3. **NCAA Division I Legislative Committee Modernization of the Rules Subcommittee official visit/student-athlete limit legislation.** The SAEC reviewed NCAA Division I Proposal 2022-32, which would amend the official and unofficial visit legislation. Specifically, the SAEC expressed the importance of and requested data on the frequency of official visits in all sports (e.g., post-COVID and after the newly implemented transfer legislation).
4. **American Baseball Coaches Association request to increase institutional official visit limitations.** The SAEC reviewed a request from the American Baseball Coaches Association to increase the institutional limit on official visits from 25 to 40. Institutions were previously allowed 40 official visits for the 2021-22 academic year based on a blanket waiver approved in January 2022. The SAEC will continue to discuss this request at a future meeting.
