NCAA DIVISION I STUDENT-ATHLETE EXPERIENCE COMMITTEE
JANUARY 9, 2024, IN-PERSON MEETING**

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Update from the NCAA Committee on Competitive Safeguards and Medical Aspects of Sports (CSMAS).** The NCAA Division I Student-Athlete Experience Committee (SAEC) received an update on the work of the Mental Health Advisory Group and on legislative recommendations from CSMAS.
2. **Review of student-athlete health and wellness survey.** SAEC received an update from the NCAA research staff on the student-athlete health and wellness survey.
3. **Transfer issues – undergraduate four-year transfers – review of transfer data and 4-4 undergraduate transfer waivers.** SAEC received an update on transfer data and waivers as well as an update on the October NCAA Division I Board of Directors charge for staff and appropriate committees to develop legislative and/or policy modifications to improve the waiver process.
4. **Review of council-governance legislation anticipated for January vote.** SAEC reviewed and updated its position on any council-governance sponsored proposals scheduled for January vote. Additionally, the committee reviewed proposals originally recommended by SAEC to confirm no modifications are necessary.
5. **Best practices for submitting requests for legislative change to the SAEC.** SAEC reviewed and provided feedback on best practices for outside groups (e.g., coaches associations) to submit requests for legislative change to the SAEC.
6. **Tennis – prize money, private lessons and annual exemptions to the maximum number of dates of competition.** The committee reviewed and provided feedback on requests from the Intercollegiate Tennis Association to permit private lessons, exempt an exhibition dual match from the maximum dates of competition and to increase the amount of permissible prize money. The SAEC did not recommend introducing the concepts into the legislative cycle at this time.
