



**REPORT OF THE
NCAA DIVISION I STUDENT-ATHLETE EXPERIENCE COMMITTEE
July 20, 2020, VIDEOCONFERENCE**

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **NCAA Division I Transfer Waiver Working Group stakeholder feedback.** The NCAA Division I Student-Athlete Experience Committee reviewed and provided feedback to the Transfer Waiver Working Group on its notification of transfer date concept. The committee noted that a legislative date may promote consistency and competitive equity, but it would also impose new restrictions on student-athletes currently able to use the one-time transfer exception.
2. **NCAA Division I recruiting calendars.** The committee reviewed the coaching association responses to date on potential recruiting calendar modifications and indicated general support for extending the temporary COVID-19 recruiting dead period beyond August.
3. **Review of the Intercollegiate Women’s Lacrosse Coaches Association request.** The committee reviewed and discussed the request from the Intercollegiate Women’s Lacrosse Coaches Association to move the first permissible date for recruiting activities to occur in the sport of women’s lacrosse from September 1 at the beginning of the junior year in high school to July 1 following completion of the junior year in high school. The committee indicated a general lack of support for the request. While the committee emphasized the importance of prioritizing the health and safety of prospective student-athletes during the COVID-19 pandemic, the committee also noted the importance of establishing relationships with prospective student-athletes enrolling in fall 2022. Additionally, the committee indicated a preference to consistently apply the current application of recruiting legislation across all sports instead of individual sport reviews.
4. **NCAA Division I Committee for Legislative Relief Waiver stakeholder feedback.** The Student-Athlete Experience Committee reviewed and provided feedback on the Committee on Legislative Relief’s request to increase in baseball the number of days in the playing and practice season from 132 to 144 and to increase the fall segment from 45 consecutive days to 60 consecutive days. The Student-Athlete Experience Committee indicated a lack of support for the blanket waiver, noting the increase on student-athlete time and institutional resources to support a lengthened season.
