



**INFORMATIONAL ITEMS OF THE
NCAA DIVISION I STUDENT-ATHLETE EXPERIENCE COMMITTEE
OCTOBER 4, 2022, MEETING**

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Review report from the August NCAA Division I Student-Athlete Experience Committee videoconference.** The NCAA Division I Student-Athlete Experience Committee (SAEC) approved the August 15, 2022, videoconference report.
2. **NCAA Division I Student-Athlete Advisory Committee season of competition.** The SAEC discussed and provided feedback on a legislative concept to amend the season of competition legislation. The SAEC encouraged the consideration of data surrounding participation in a fifth year of athletics (e.g., impact on academic outcomes and recruiting).
3. **NCAA Division I Legislative Committee Modernization of the Rules Subcommittee update.** The SAEC received an update from staff on the work of the NCAA Division I Legislative Committee Modernization of the Rules Subcommittee.
4. **Sport-specific legislative concepts from coaching associations.** The SAEC revisited previously considered sport-specific legislative concepts from coaching associations for possible introduction into the 2022-23 legislative cycle.
5. **Fencing – local sports club concept.** The SAEC discussed a sport-specific legislative concept from the United States Fencing Coaches Association to amend local sports club legislation. The SAEC did not recommend introducing the concept into the legislative cycle at this time due to the ongoing work of the NCAA Division I Transformation Committee and the Modernization of the Rules Subcommittee.
6. **Transfer windows legislative concept.** The SAEC received an update from staff regarding the application of recently adopted notification of transfer legislation and will work with sport communities to evaluate potential modifications as appropriate.
7. **Future teleconferences via Microsoft Teams and in-person meeting.** The SAEC will conduct its next teleconferences and in-person meeting on the following dates and times:
