



**SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT OF THE  
NCAA DIVISION I STUDENT-ATHLETE EXPERIENCE COMMITTEE  
OCTOBER 2-3, 2023, IN-PERSON MEETING**

**INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.**

1. **Update on transfer waivers.** The NCAA Division I Student-Athlete Experience Committee (SAEC) received an update on four-year undergraduate transfer waivers and potential changes to the postgraduate transfer waiver previously approved waiver.
2. **Review men's and women's soccer playing and practice season – blanket waiver.** The SAEC provided feedback on a potential blanket waiver to start the 2024-25 men's and women's soccer championship playing season one week early.
3. **In-season foreign competition legislation.** The SAEC discussed expanding opportunities for student-athletes to engage in in-season foreign competition during the playing season in sports other than football and men's and women's basketball. The committee agreed that the current legislative framework for in-season foreign competition is appropriate and did not recommend further discussion.
4. **Update on the NCAA Division I Legislative Pilot Process.** The SAEC received an update on the legislative pilot process with an emphasis on the options for anticipated legislative action during the October meeting of the Division I Council.
5. **Review 2023-24 NCAA Division I Council-governance recommended proposals.** The SAEC reviewed a proposal it recommended for introduction into the legislative cycle to codify aspects of the published council-approved review process guidelines related to delayed enrollment. Specifically, the committee determined that the scope of the proposal should be limited to minimal participation and low-level/loosely organized competition.
6. **Recruiting calendar legislation.** The SAEC received an update on the legislative process involved to amend sport-specific recruiting calendar legislation. The SAEC recommended seeking feedback from the Division I Legislative Committee and sport oversight committees about whether policy alternatives to legislating recruiting calendars should be explored.
7. **Women's golf – recruiting calendar.** The SAEC reviewed and discussed a request from the coaches' association to create a recruiting calendar for women's golf. The committee requested clarification on the rationale for adopting a recruiting calendar.
8. **Men's ice hockey – Spengler Cup.** The SAEC discussed a request from College Hockey Inc. to allow student-athletes to participate in the Spengler Cup, an international competition that occurs during the academic year. The committee requested additional information and will continue to consider the request at a future meeting.
