**INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.**

1. **Review of institutions reclassifying from Division II to Division I.** The NCAA Division I Strategic Vision and Planning Committee reviewed information from each of the institutions in the Division II to Division I membership reclassification process and took the following action:
  - a. Bellarmine University has been advanced to year three of the reclassification process;
  - b. California Baptist University has been advanced to active membership in Division I;
  - c. Utah Tech University has been advanced to year three of the reclassification process;
  - d. University of North Alabama has been advanced to active membership in Division I;
  - e. Merrimack College has been advanced to year four of the reclassification process;
  - f. Tarleton State University has been advanced to year three of the reclassification process; and
  - g. University of California, San Diego has been advanced to year three of the reclassification process.
2. **Review of institution reclassifying from Division III to Division I.** The committee reviewed information from the institution in the Division III to Division I reclassification process and took the following action:
  - University of St. Thomas (Minnesota) has been advanced to enter year two of the reclassification process in 2021-22.

  - d. Texas A&M University-Commerce has been accepted into the reclassification process; and
  - e. Queen University of Charlotte has been accepted into the reclassification process.
4. Review of initial application of reclassification institutions from **Division I Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) to Division I Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS)**. The committee reviewed information from the institution in the Division I FCS to Division I FBS reclassification process and took the following action:
