



**REPORT OF THE NCAA DIVISION I
MEN'S AND WOMEN'S BASKETBALL OVERSIGHT COMMITTEES
APRIL 21, 2023, JOINT MEETING**

ACTION ITEMS.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Championship and Division I Women's Basketball Championship update.** The NCAA Division I Men's and Women's Oversight Committees received an update on the student-athlete experience and changes made to ensure equitable experiences at both men's and women's basketball championships.
2. **Update on the college basketball summer initiative for men's and women's basketball.** The oversight committees received an update on the work of both the men's and women's summer basketball initiative working groups and feedback gathered from the coaches' associations conventions at the respective Final Fours, conference spring meetings and the Division I Council meeting. Early feedback continues to be generally supportive with the notion of continuing to consider flexibility in the parameters of the concept. Questions surrounding how these events will be conducted have been raised and the working group will continue to discuss this and additional issues on future videoconferences. A formal survey will be sent in early May to Division I conferences to seek formal feedback from basketball student-athletes, coaches, and administrators. The data gathered will assist the working groups to determine whether to recommend a legislative change to the oversight committees that would permit summer competition beginning summer 2024.
3. **NCAA Division I Legislative Committee Legislative Process Subgroup discussion.** The committees received an update on the processes under development to implement legislative changes within the new Division I decision-making governance structure. The current recommendations are focused on developing new processes that provide the appropriate checks and balances without being overly bureaucratic.
4. **USA Basketball update.** USA Basketball's men's and women's national team directors provided an overview of the U16 and U18 FIBA Americas Championships, and their interest in hosting these events in the United States. USA Basketball would like to host these events and training camps on Division I college campuses, which is currently not permitted by NCAA recruiting rules. The oversight committees expressed interest in hearing feedback from the coaches and charged the National Association of Basketball Coaches and Women's Basketball Coaches Association to gather input from their membership to share during the July joint oversight committees' meeting.
5. **NCAA College Basketball Academy update.** The oversight committees approved dates for the 2024 College Basketball Academy to allow the bid process to begin to determine the location and host – Dates for men's basketball are July 22-25, 2024, and women's basketball are July 26-29, 2024.

6. **Other business.** The oversight committees reviewed three topics to continue to track on at future joint meetings:
- **Seasons of Competition:** The oversight committees received an update on the seasons of competition concepts that have been previously discussed. The oversight committees agreed the topic is not ripe for discussion at this time due to the desire to wait to see the impact of the new transfer windows and transfer waiver guidelines on any potential changes to the currently eligibility model, data collection on the football four-game rule with results expected in mid-May 2023, and NCAA Division I Student-Athlete Advisory Committee's plan to review the five-year competition model for all sports in July 2023.
 - **Coach Representation in the Division I Governance Structure:** The oversight committees discussed making a request to the Division I Council Coordination Committee to have coaches address the Council to share their experiences with the current transfer environment. It was noted that the request should also include men's and women's basketball student-athletes. The coaches expressed a desire for a greater men's and women's basketball coaching voice and representation at the Council level within the new governance structure.
 - **Continued Review of Transfer Legislation in Basketball:** The oversight committees expressed their desire in continuing to review transfer legislation in basketball.
7. **NCAA Division I Men's and Women's Basketball Oversight Committees' January 10 joint meeting report.** The oversight committees reviewed and approved the January 10 joint meeting report.
