NCAA DIVISION I MEN'S AND WOMEN'S BASKETBALL OVERSIGHT COMMITTEES
JUNE 1-2, 2026, JOINT MEETINGS**

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Key topics and potential action items for the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Oversight Committee and Men's Basketball Oversight Committee June 1-2 meetings.** The oversight committees received a preview of the key topics and agenda items that were scheduled for discussion during their individual oversight committee meetings. The oversight committees convened jointly following the conclusion of the individual meetings and shared the outcomes of their deliberations on key topics and agenda items. The following are key areas that were identified for the joint meetings:

- a. NCA Division I Bylaw 17 playing and practice seasons decentralization review and feedback to the NCAA Division I Cabinet. (MBOC and WBOC)
- b. Changes to the playing and practice season. (MBOC and WBOC)
- c. Timing of the undergraduate notification of transfer window. (MBOC and WBOC)
- d. Comprehensive evaluation of the Division I women's basketball recruiting calendar and associated bylaws. (WBOC only)
- e. Complimentary admissions to away-from-home competition for signed prospective student-athletes and parents/legal guardians. (WBOC only)
- f. Division I men's basketball coach attendance at Division I contests, including other conference tournaments. (MBOC only)
- g. Out-of-season activities model. (MBOC only)

2. **Expansion of the NCAA Division I basketball tournaments to 76 teams.** Due to time constraints, the oversight committees will address this agenda item at a future meeting.
3. **Future combined men's and women's Final Fours.** Val Ackerman, commissioner of the Big East Conference, shared a request to the oversight committees to consider a combined men's and women's Final Four in the near future. The benefits that could be realized by such an event for the media, sponsors, host school and conference, and institutional

commissioners and administrators were highlighted. The oversight committees will determine the next steps in their consideration of the request.

4. Other business. The oversight committees conducted no other business.
