INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

- **Comprehensive review of the qualifying regular season multiple-team event legislation and maximum number of contests.** In preparation for the March 26 deadline to introduce legislation into June pilot legislative process, the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Oversight Committee reviewed its previous action and feedback received from the membership and stakeholder groups. At its February meeting, the oversight committee introduced legislation into the June 2025 Division I pilot legislative process to limit an institution's total regular-season playing schedule with outside competition to 31 contests and eliminate the qualifying regular-season multiple-team event requirements, effective with the 2024-25 season. The oversight committee will be meeting jointly with the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee to determine support for one proposal for both men's and women's basketball to be introduced into the June pilot legislative process.
