WOMEN'S BASKETBALL OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE
MAY 10, 2023, VIDEOCONFERENCE

ACTION ITEMS.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Update on the Championships Media Consultant.** The NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Oversight Committee received an update from Endeavor on the current media landscape in the United States including key trends and considerations. An overview of past, current and future media rights grants among the sport industry was presented to the oversight committee. The oversight committee shared feedback and encouraged guarantees of national exposure, maximum revenue and high-quality production of the women's basketball championship.
2. **Update from the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Committee.** The oversight committee received an overview of highlights from the most recent meeting of the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Committee. Key areas of discussion included a recap of the 2023 championship, including Women's Final Four and student-athlete experience initiatives. The Women's Basketball Committee also provided feedback to the Women's Basketball Oversight Committee on the college basketball summer initiative and the College Basketball Academy.
3. **Update from the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Rules Committee.** An informational update from the Women's Basketball Rules Committee's most recent meeting was provided. The Women's Basketball Rules Committee approved 11 rules changes, the most notable being the flopping penalty and the reduction of the restricted area under the basket. The Playing Rules Oversight Panel is soliciting membership feedback on the proposed rules changes to be considered at its next meeting on June 8, 2023.
4. **College Basketball Summer Initiative update.** An overview of the concept and timeline for the review and consideration by the Division I membership was provided to the Women's Basketball Oversight Committee. A survey was distributed to the membership to provide feedback on the proposed concepts and is due on June 9, 2023.
5. **Update on the new 32-team Division I women's basketball postseason event.** The Women's Basketball Oversight Committee received an update on the timeline for the event, including staff and resource needs to successfully conduct the inaugural event in 2024. The Women's Basketball Oversight Committee will continue to receive updates as implementation progresses.
6. **NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Oversight Committee's April 18 videoconference report.** Due to time constraints, the Women's Basketball Oversight Committee will review and vote on its April 18, 2023, videoconference report at its June meeting.

7. **Other business.**

- Recruitment of transfer student-athletes. The occurrence of coaches recruiting on another institution's campus will be a topic for discussion at the next joint NCAA Division I Men's and Women's Basketball Oversight Committee meeting. The Women's Basketball Oversight Committee supported the exploration of legislation to either prohibit or limit this type of contact.
