Quota of 25 percent administrators: **2**. [NOTE: The DII/DIII representative does not count towards the administrator requirement.]  
[In November, 2001, the Board of Directors adopted legislation to exempt the Women's Gymnastics Committee from the requirement that no subdivision of Division I shall have more than 50 percent representation on any Division I committee.]

**Duties:** Responsible for developing policies and procedures governing the administration and conduct of the NCAA championships under its jurisdiction. Also, reviewing issues related to the sport.
