- **2026 men's lacrosse championship site recommendation.** The Division II Championships Committee approved the recommendation from the Division II Men's Lacrosse Committee that the University of Virginia host the 2026 Division II Men's Lacrosse Championship in conjunction with the Divisions I and III championships at Scott Stadium in Charlottesville, Virginia. The action is necessary as the originally selected host for the joint championships in 2026, Gillette Stadium in Foxborough, Massachusetts, is unable to host due to subsequently being selected as a host site for the 2026 FIFA World Cup. The University of Virginia has presented several suitable hotel options that meet minimum requirements for the teams and officials and will be able to host this championship with an emphasis not only on the student-athlete experience but also an enhanced fan experience.
