ACTION ITEMS.

1. Legislative Items.

2. Nonlegislative Items.

- **NCAA Division II Constitution 6.3.1 - Institutional Control - Self-Study and Evaluation – Pause of the Institutional Self-Study Guide.**
  - (1) Recommendation. Pause the completion of the Institutional Self-Study Guide (ISSG) set forth in Constitution 6.3.1 (self-study report) for active Division II member institutions.
  - (2) Effective date. Immediate, for the 2021-22 reporting year, and thereafter.
  - (3) Rationale. During the 2022 NCAA Convention, delegates adopted a revised Association-wide constitution. The NCAA Division II Membership Committee noted that the topics and questions set forth in the current ISSG do not align with the new constitution. Therefore, the committee agreed to recommend that the completion of the ISSG be paused for active Division II member institutions. The committee further noted its support of the elimination of the current legislative requirements in this area. Finally, the committee agreed that provisional institutions must complete the ISSG as part of the Division II membership process.
  - (4) Estimated budget impact. None.
  - (5) Student-athlete impact. None.
