- 1. Opening remarks and review of schedule and agenda.** Division III Championships Committee Chair Chuck Mitrano welcomed the group and introduced new NCAA staff member Margaret Gaines, who will provide additional assistance with committee operations.

Gender Equity Review update.** Staff members John Baldwin and Leigh Ann Price, who are overseeing internal efforts to implement recommendations emanating from the Gender Equity Review, joined the videoconference to update the committee on the process to ensure that all NCAA championships are being conducted equitably. The process includes a multi-question survey that all championship managers are required to complete that identifies what, if any, inequities exist. In instances where inequities are identified, the review then entails whether they are justified, either logistically or for other legitimate reasons specific to the sport, site, venue or the championship itself.
