- 1. **Review February Report.** The committee reviewed the report from its February 18, 2021, videoconference.
- 2. Discuss alternative playing and practice season model. The committee continued its discussion of the alternative playing and practice season model. The committee considered feedback received to date from the membership concerning the alternative model and reviewed a summary of the division's review of the playing and practice season legislation that has occurred since 2004. The committee reiterated its commitment to reviewing Article 17 and engaging the membership to determine if legislative changes are warranted. This review and engagement will occur over the next year to ensure appropriate consideration is given to the varying perspectives on this topic.

Additionally, the committee considered whether the alternative model or any element of the model should be considered for the 2021-22 academic year. The committee agreed that the waiver should not be extended for the 2021-22 academic year and that there should be a return to the standards set forth in the current legislation. This includes all start dates for the fall of 2021, as well as all other playing and practice season regulations as set forth in Article 17.
