The committee denied a waiver of Bylaw 20.11.4.8 (minimum contests and participants requirements for sports sponsorship) for the 2023-24 academic year from York College (New York) for the sports of men's cross country, women's cross country, women's swimming and diving, women's swimming and diving, men's indoor track and field, women's indoor track and field, men's outdoor track and field and women's outdoor track and field, noting insufficient mitigation.
- 6. Consideration of a Regional Rules Waiver. The committee reviewed and approved a waiver request from Carroll University (Wisconsin) for the 2025 Regional Rules Seminar attendance (Bylaw 20.8.4.15) based on sufficient mitigation. The institution must attend the Regional Rules Seminar in 2026.
- 7. Consideration of a Conference Rules Seminar request. The committee approved an application from the New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference to host a Conference Rules Seminar in 2025.
- **8. Recap of campus visits.** The committee received an update on the campus visits to Johnson & Wales Charlotte and Regent University. Both institutions are in the exploratory year.
