**INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.**

1. **Welcome and announcements.** Kate Pigsley, chair of the NCAA Board of Governors Student-Athlete Engagement Committee, welcomed the committee members to the videoconference.
2. **Review of the Board of Governors Student-Athlete Engagement Committee July 20, 2023, videoconference report.** The committee did not review or approve the report from the July 20, 2023, videoconference. The committee did not have a quorum on the videoconference to approve the report.
