- 1. Review of the Rwandan TVET Level 5 Certificate.** The committee reviewed and unanimously approved the Rwandan “TVET Level 5 Certificate” as acceptable proof of high school graduation. This will have a 12-year expected timeline associated with it (four years or eight semesters from initial enrollment in year nine), and will be considered a category two, exam-based credential for old model purposes. This will be published in the next available update to the Guide to International Academic Standards for Athletics Eligibility.
