INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Selection of new chair.** Hanna Lantz will serve as the new chair of the committee moving forward.
2. **Eux diploma from Denmark.** A new vocational diploma offered to students in Denmark, the Eux, is now approved for use as acceptable proof of high school graduation. The expected timeline for completion will be listed as 11 years, total, or three years from initial enrollment in the ninth year of compulsory education in that system. This will be published in the next available update to the Guide to International Academic Standards for Athletics Eligibility.
3. **National Examinations Council (NECO) as an issuing body.** The national Examinations Council, or “NECO”, will be accepted as an issuing body for the Senior School Certificate (SSCE) in Nigeria. This will be published in the next available update to the Guide to International Academic Standards for Athletics Eligibility.
