INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Review of the Tutkintotodistus vocational credential from Finland. CTEC Level 3 and Level 3 Extended Diplomas from the United Kingdom.** The committee reviewed and unanimously approved the “Tutkintotodistus” vocational qualification from Finland as acceptable proof of high school graduation. The qualification will have a 12-year expected timeline (four years or eight semesters from initial enrollment in year nine). This credential will be considered category two for old model purposes. This information will be published in the next available update to the Guide to International Academic Standards for Athletics Eligibility.

2. **Review of the “S” designation in Australia Capital Territory.** The committee reviewed and unanimously determined that the designation of “S” where a grade would typically appear should be listed to indicate a medical reason the student was unable to receive a standard grade for the course. In this instance, no grade or credit will be awarded. This information will be published in the next available update to the Guide to International Academic Standards for Athletics Eligibility.
