APRIL 21, 2020, MEETING**

**ACTION ITEMS.**

**1. Legislative items.**

**2. Nonlegislative items.**

- **NCAA Division I Committee on Academics and NCAA Division II Academic Requirements Committee.**
  - Recommendation. Approve 2020-21 NCAA International Student Records Committee policies and procedures.
  - Effective date. Immediate.
  - Rationale. No language was added or adjusted for the 2020-21 cycle.
  - Estimated budget impact. None.

**INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.**

- 1. Committee roster.** The committee reviewed the roster and made one adjustment to the contact information listed.
- 2. Committee chair and co-chair.** The committee selected Meghan Miller as the incoming Chair, and Brittany Henson as the incoming co-chair of the Committee, by unanimous vote.
- 3. Outreach and strategic partnerships update.** The committee learned about the efforts the Eligibility Center staff has been making to increase awareness of initial-eligibility requirements in the international community.
- 4. Eligibility Center vision.** The committee was updated regarding the Eligibility Center vision.
- 5. Eligibility Center response to COVID-19.** The committee was updated regarding the Eligibility Center response to COVID-19, and the impact it may have on the international community. The membership FAQ was reviewed as a part of this conversation.

6. **Notification of discontinuation of old model phase out.** The committee was notified that the old model certification method will not be phased out, as planned, for Fall 2021 enrollees.
7. **Review of United Kingdom’s BTEC credential name changes.** The committee reviewed the research presented for several new BTEC titles. The committee tabled the review until additional research is completed. Eligibility at the next possible opportunity. The rationale for approval was based in the research reviewed which corroborated the presented information.
8. **Other business.** The committee discussed the tentative timeline for finding a new member. NCAA staff updated the committee on the new listing for Macao and Northern Macedonia, based on AP styling updates. NCAA staff also gave an update on the new and old model tracking that staff is facilitating to ensure the transition from two possible certification attempts to one is as successful as possible. The committee discussed the format of the teleconferences. The committee determined that the teleconferences will remain in the current format and should not be adjusted at this time. This decision will be revisited during the October teleconference.
