INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

- 1. Review committee report. The committee reviewed and approved the report from its July 10, 2025, teleconference.
- 2. Review of the Baccalauréat credential from Switzerland. The committee reviewed and approved the Baccalauréat credential from Switzerland as acceptable proof of high school graduation. The Baccalauréat credential will have an expected timeline consistent with the specific Swiss canton in which the credential is earned (e.g., Bern canton would have an expected timeline of 12 years, Uri canton would have an expected timeline of 13 years). Additionally, the credential will be considered equivalent to those Switzerland credentials already listed in item no. 1 under acceptable forms of proof of graduation and will appear in the Guide to International Academic Standards for Athletics Eligibility as follows:
 - Schweizerische Eidgenössisches Maturitätzeugnis/Confédération Suiss de maturité/Confederrazione Svizzera attestato di maturità/Baccalauréat [Swiss Federal Maturity Certificate]

The credential will be considered category one for old model purposes. This will be published in the next available update to the Guide to International Academic Standards for Athletics Eligibility.
