INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. Review of credential from Queensland, Australia. The committee reviewed a new credential from Queensland, Australia titled, "Queensland Certificate of Individual Achievement" (QCIA). The review included information provided directly from Queensland Curriculum & Assessment Authority, which is the issuing body of the credential. The committee denied the credential as acceptable proof of high school graduation, based on the inability to satisfy requirement 2c of the NCAA International Student Records Committee Policy on Proof of High School Graduation. This requirement states that for a credential to be reviewed as potential proof of high school graduation, the credential must provide access to further education in country. This information will be included in the next available publishing of the NCAA Guide to International Academic Standards for Athletic Eligibility.
