

**REPORT OF THE
NCAA INTERNATIONAL STUDENT RECORDS COMMITTEE
JUNE 3, 2019, MEETING**

ACTION ITEMS.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

- 1. Latvian grading scale.** The committee reviewed information provided by the National Centre for Education Republic of Latvia. This information spoke to the 10-point grading scale listed in the 2020-21 Guide to International Academic Standards for Initial Eligibility. The committee decided that no changes should be made to the current scale listed. The rationale was based on the information provided for review, and the lack of compelling evidence for an update. The information focused on awarding grades based on one student's orientation within a larger population of students. Typically, it is more compelling to receive information for how students are assessed based on their individual achievement, the grade earned by that student, and what that grade means.
- 2. Andorran country profile.** The committee reviewed information supplied by the Andorran government and additional information located through research and approved a new country profile for Andorra. The profile will be included in the next available publishing of the NCAA Guide to International Academic Standards for Athletics Eligibility.
- 3. BTEC title review.** The committee reviewed several new titles associated with the BTEC path of study in the United Kingdom. The credential titles were voted on as follows: "BTEC Level 3 National Diploma in Sport" and "BTEC Level 3 National Extended Diploma in Sport" are both approved as acceptable proof of high school graduation. "BTEC Level 3 National Extended Certificate in Sport" and "BTEC Level 3 National Foundation Diploma in Sport" will be listed as not acceptable forms of proof of high school graduation. The decision on these titles was largely based in the guided learning hours required within the curriculum of each credential. The profile will be included in the next available publishing of the NCAA Guide to International Academic Standards for Initial Eligibility.
