

# REPORT OF THE NCAA INTERNATIONAL STUDENT RECORDS COMMITTEE MAY 31, 2024, MEETING

#### ACTION ITEMS.

#### INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. Removal of Spain's "Titulo de Técnico Superior" Diploma as Acceptable Proof of Graduation. The committee reviewed and unanimously approved the removal of Spain's "Titulo de Técnico Superior" credential as an acceptable form of proof of graduation from the Guide to International Academic Standards for Athletics Eligibility. Based on clarification from the Spanish Ministry of Education, the "Titulo de Técnico Superior" is a university-level credential and therefore cannot also be considered secondary-level education for proof of graduation in Spain. Additionally, the "Titulo de Técnico Superior" will now be listed as a not acceptable form of proof of graduation in the Guide to International Academic Standards for Athletics Eligibility. This new entry will also include a corresponding disclaimer explaining how the credential will still be honored as acceptable proof of graduation if a student enrolled in the two-year program on, or prior to, May 31, 2027 (to ensure that no student is disadvantaged in their potential reliance on the prior listing of the credential as acceptable proof of graduation).
