- 1. **Review committee report.** The committee reviewed and approved the report from its May 1, 2025, teleconference.
- 2. Review of the 1st4sport Level 3 Diploma in Sporting Excellence credential from the United Kingdom. The committee reviewed and tabled the proposed addition of the United Kingdom's "1st4sport Level 3 Diploma in Sporting Excellence" credential as a not acceptable form of proof of graduation in the Guide to International Academic Standards for Athletics Eligibility. Based on research, the credential does not appear to lead to further education within the United Kingdom and is a qualification for occupational employment only. The committee determined that additional clarification about this factor from the entity 1st4sport/UK Coaching and/or the United Kingdom Ministry of Education needs to be answered first. After 1st4sport/UK Coaching and/or the Ministry answers those questions, the committee will review the information again.
