INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

- 1. New Zealand grading scale review.** A review of New Zealand’s NZQA grading scale was completed. The descriptors of “blank” and “NA” will be removed from the grading scale, as both descriptors are meant to show when an assessment of a course has not yet been completed or was never completed. This information will be included in the next available publishing of the NCAA Guide to International Academic Standards for Athletic Eligibility.

- 2. Republic of Seychelles credential review.** The discussion surrounding the information collected on the Diploma of Business Studies and Accounting resulted in approval of the credential as acceptable proof of high school graduation (POG). The expected graduation timeline associated with this document is fourteen years total (three years from on-time completion of tier one POG) and is considered a second tier form of POG. This information will be included in the next available publishing of the NCAA Guide to International Academic Standards for Athletic Eligibility.
