



**REPORT OF THE  
NCAA HIGH SCHOOL REVIEW COMMITTEE  
APRIL 24-25, 2023, MEETING**

ACTION ITEMS.

**1. Legislative items.**

- None.

**2. Nonlegislative items.**

- a. Appoint new chair and vice-chair.** The committee voted unanimously to appoint William Morrison and David Stein as the next chair and vice-chair, respectively.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

- 1. Review meeting report.** The committee reviewed and approved the report from its January 26 videoconference.
- 2. High school review staff updates.** The committee received an update on 2022 work volume, trends, and improvement initiatives from high school review staff.
- 3. Review proposed updates to committee policies and procedures.** The committee reviewed and discussed additions to its policies and procedures. The updates will be incorporated into the 2023-24 version and approved by electronic vote following the meeting.
  - a. Experiential learning:** The committee supported the addition of criteria for review of experiential learning curriculum based on content and rigor of performance tasks and assessments.
  - b. Bridge math courses:** The committee supported the addition of criteria for review of “bridge” math courses commonly taken in the fourth year of high school.
  - c. Duplicative coursework:** The committee supported the addition of criteria for review of duplicative courses based on content and rigor of performance tasks and assessments.
  - d. Ad hoc committee members:** The committee supported the addition of a policy regarding the role and responsibilities of non-voting ad hoc members.
- 4. Discuss considerations for program reviews.** The committee reviewed and discussed policies and criteria related to reviews of instructional models and nontraditional courses (e.g., online, blended, credit recovery), and provided initial feedback for possible adjustments to the criteria for review should the current draft of modernized core-course legislation be approved.

5. **Future-focused education discussion.** The committee participated in a facilitated activity and discussion regarding the likelihood of various potential changes in education for future NCAA prospective student-athletes and the impact of those changes on the committee's work.
