

REPORT OF THE NCAA HIGH SCHOOL REVIEW COMMITTEE DECEMBER 12, 2024, VIDEOCONFERENCE

ACTION ITEMS.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

- 1. Update on high school appeal submissions. The committee received an update on two recent appeals submitted by high schools. One appeal was acted upon by the chair of the NCAA High School Review Committee under the authority granted by the policies and procedures. The other appeal was withdrawn by the high school.
- **2. Review of core course scenarios.** The committee reviewed and discussed case studies presented by staff based on scenarios that have arisen since the implementation of modernized core course legislation.
 - **a. Core course instruction criteria.** The committee discussed the role of the teacher in core courses used for initial eligibility, per NCAA core course legislation. The committee recommended the development of additional criteria for review to be discussed at its annual meeting.
 - **b. Credit recovery.** The committee discussed credit recovery courses and their alignment with NCAA legislation. Specifically, the committee reviewed scenarios in which the design of such courses allows students to test out of course material. The committee recommended no changes to the current policy and process related to credit recovery courses.
 - c. PSA Review course completion. The committee discussed the PSA Review process and the role of program tasks in seeking information about the completion of core courses by prospective student-athletes when PSA Review triggers are met. The committee determined that continued review of PSA Review trends is needed. The PSA Review trigger list will be reviewed at the committee's annual meeting.
- **3. Future meetings.** Biweekly meetings are tentatively scheduled for appeals or other business and canceled if not necessary.
