

REPORT OF THE NCAA HIGH SCHOOL REVIEW COMMITTEE JULY 25, 2024, VIDEOCONFERENCE

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

- 1. Evolution of NCAA initial eligibility requirements. The committee received an historical overview of key changes in core course, GPA, and standardized test score requirements for prospective student-athletes over the past several decades. The overview included highlights of data underlying the changes as well as rationale for past committee recommendations. The information was requested during a discussion at the committee's annual meeting in April 2024 and will provide a foundation for ongoing analysis by the committee to ensure alignment of NCAA requirements with current practices in secondary education.
- **2. Update on modernized core course legislation implementation.** The committee received an update on the implementation plans for updates to NCAA Divisions I and II Bylaw 14.3.1.3, which were approved at the 2024 NCAA Convention and are effective for reviews on or after August 1, 2024.
- **3. Future meetings.** Biweekly meetings are tentatively scheduled for appeals or other business and canceled if not necessary.
