INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Welcome.** The chair convened the meeting and welcomed the committee.
2. **Report of the NCAA Postgraduate Scholarship Committee meeting.** The committee approved the report of its May 5, 2025, meeting.
3. **Review spring sports nominations.** The committee reviewed 118 spring sports applications (44 men and 74 women). The committee awarded 21 postgraduate scholarships for participants in men's sports and 21 postgraduate scholarships for participants in women's sports.
4. **Review future meeting schedule.** The committee meetings for the 2025-26 academic year will be held virtually.
5. **Select a new incoming chair.** The committee selected Heather Ryan, Duke University, to be the chair for the 2025-26 academic year.
6. **Meet with the regional committee chairs.** The committee met with the regional committee chairs. They discussed the possibility of reverting the deadline for using a post-grad scholarship from two years to one year. The committee also began discussions on selection criteria for candidates. The discussion was tabled for a future meeting.
