**INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.**

- **NCAA Softball Rules Committee Experimental Rule Request.** The NCAA Playing Rules Oversight Panel approved an experimental rule for conference play only submitted by the Softball Rules Committee, which included allowing an unlimited number of replays on the in-venue videoboard, at any speed, while a play is under video review by the umpires. Once a decision has been made by the umpires and/or review officials, no further replays shall be shown on the videoboard. The videoboard may not show any feed or footage of the play that was not available to the umpires and/or replay officials. On plays that are not under video review, the current policy of allowing one replay at full speed still applies.
