

Recruiting Essentials: Contacts and Evaluations

OFF-CAMPUS RECRUITING OPPORTUNITIES

Any activity designed to assess the academic and athletic qualifications of a prospect.



CONTACTS

A face-to-face encounter in excess of an exchange of a greeting, including when a staff member takes a position where contact is possible.



EVALUATIONS

Any off-campus activity designed to assess the academic qualifications or athletics ability of a prospect, including any visit to a prospect's school.

SPORT	ANNUAL RECRUITING OPPORTUNITIES (CONTACTS AND EVALUATIONS COMBINED)	ADDITIONAL RESTRICTIONS
Men's Basketball	Seven (Sept. 1-May 31)	Contact may only occur at a prospect's school during their junior year.
Women's Basketball	Seven (Aug. 1-May 31)	Contact may only occur at a prospect's school or home.
Football	Two per contact period (Does not include fall evaluation period)	Junior Year <ul style="list-style-type: none">One visit at the prospect's school, one at any location. Senior Year <ul style="list-style-type: none">Two per contact period.
All Other Sports	Seven (Sept. 1-May 31)	Maximum of three contacts. In lacrosse, contacts may only occur at a prospect's school or home.

Women's Basketball	65 recruiting person days (Aug. 1-March 31)	<p>MONTHS OTHER THAN JUNE OR JULY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Regularly scheduled scholastic practice and competition. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Regular scholastic activities involving PSAs at their school. • International scholastic or nonscholastic practice and competition. <p>APRIL/MAY EVALUATION PERIODS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Events certified by the NCAA. <p>JUNE</p> <p>Scholastic and intercollegiate events that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are approved by the NFSHSA, NCAA or applicable two-year college governing body. • Are organized and conducted exclusively by the applicable high school or two-year college athletics or coaches association. • Occur at any location other than an NCAA DI institution. <p>JULY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Institutional basketball camps. • Events certified by the NCAA. • Events approved and conducted by an applicable state, national or international governing body not organized for recruiting.

Events organized and conducted exclusively by the applicable high school or two-year college athletics association. <p>FCS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Scholastic or nonscholastic athletics activities, provided there is no institutional involvement in arranging the activity.

All Other Sports	<p>Men's Golf 45 evaluation days</p> <p>Women's Golf 55 evaluation days</p> <p>Women's Volleyball 80 evaluation days</p> <p>Women's Beach Volleyball 50 evaluation days</p>	<p>WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Involvement outside the contact or evaluation period with a local sports club counts toward the evaluation days limit. Involvement with noninstitutional camps or clinics outside a 50-mile radius of the institution counts toward the evaluation days limit. <p>WOMEN'S BEACH VOLLEYBALL</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Involvement outside the contact or evaluation period with a local sports club counts toward the evaluation days limit.
