Former Student-Athlete Degree Achievement Program

- Former student-athlete.
- Must meet criteria for funding established by the student-athlete degree completion legislation (Bylaw 15.01.5.2.1).
- Must submit completed application for funding by specified deadline.

Student-Athlete Degree Completion Assistance

- · Former student-athlete.
- Division I membership requirement.
- Must meet criteria for funding established by the student-athlete degree completion legislation (Bylaw 15.01.5.2.1).

NCAA Degree Completion Program

- Tuition, fees, allowance for books.
- Fewer than 30 hours remaining.
- Must be entering at least sixth year of postsecondary education.
- Must submit completed application for funding.

The former student-athlete is eligible to receive funding if the criteria above are satisfied.

The NCAA has established a fund for limited resource institutions defined as such by the NCAA Division I Academic Performance Program within the past five years. Division I institutions that provide athletics aid are required, as a condition and obligation of membership, to fund a degree completion program. The NCAA will provide funding for former student-athletes who meet the criteria above.
