<p align="center">Women’s Ice Hockey  Dead and Quiet Periods</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• November 9-12, 2020 (Monday through Thursday of the initial week for the fall signing of the National Letter of Intent).</li> <li>• March 18-22 (noon), 2021 (the day prior to the NCAA Division I Women’s Ice Hockey Championship to noon on the day after the match).</li> <li>• Quiet Period: Monday prior to the American Hockey Coaches Association Convention through May 31.</li> </ul>
<p align="center">Men’s Soccer  Dead and Quiet Periods</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• November 9-12, 2020 (Monday through Thursday of the initial week for the signing of the National Letter of Intent).</li> <li>• December 11-13, 2020 (Friday through Sunday of the NCAA Division I Men’s Soccer Championship). A coaching staff member may attend an event conducted in conjunction with and in the host city of the championship.</li> <li>• Quiet Period: December 23-25, 2020.</li> </ul>
