# NCAA Division II Recruiting Calendars for Sports Other Than Football and Basketball

**Note:** During the dead period immediately preceding the initial National Letter of Intent signing date, the National Letter of Intent cannot be hand delivered; it must be mailed.

### June 1, 2023, through May 31, 2024

#### Men's Lacrosse

Nov. 6 (7 a.m.) to Nov. 8 (7 a.m.), 2023, (during the 48 hours prior to 7 a.m. on the initial date for the signing of the National Letter of Intent).

**DEAD PERIOD**

Nov. 27 to Dec. 23, 2023

**QUIET PERIOD**

Dec. 4 to 12, 2023, (two days before the Intercollegiate Men's Lacrosse Coaches Association Convention through the two days following the convention).

**DEAD PERIOD**

Exception for events held in conjunction with the convention.

**EVALUATION PERIOD**

May 23 to 28 (noon), 2024, (the Thursday before the NCAA Division II Men's Lacrosse Championship to the Tuesday at noon after the championship).

**DEAD PERIOD**

#### Men's and Women's Wrestling

July 24 to 30, 2023, (the Monday before the National Wrestling Coaches Association Convention through the day of adjournment of the convention).

**DEAD PERIOD**

Nov. 6 (7 a.m.) to Nov. 8 (7 a.m.), 2023, (during the 48 hours prior to 7 a.m. on the initial date for the signing of the National Letter of Intent).

**DEAD PERIOD**

### Recruiting periods defined

#### QUIET PERIOD

A quiet period is that period of time when it is permissible to make in-person recruiting contacts only on the member institution's campus. No in-person, off-campus recruiting contacts or evaluations may be made during the quiet period.

#### DEAD PERIOD

A dead period is that period of time when it is not permissible to make in-person recruiting contacts or evaluations on or off the member institution's campus or to permit official or unofficial visits by prospective student-athletes to the institution's campus.

#### EVALUATION PERIOD

An evaluation period is that period of time when it is permissible for authorized athletics department staff members to be involved in off-campus activities designed to assess the academic qualifications and playing ability of prospective student-athletes. No in-person, off-campus recruiting contacts shall be made with the prospective student-athlete during an evaluation period.



## All Other Sports

Nov. 6 (7 a.m.) to Nov. 8 (7 a.m.), 2023, (during the 48 hours prior to 7 a.m. on the initial date for the signing of the National Letter of Intent).

### Exceptions:

**U.S. Diving National Championships**  
(Bylaw 13.17.5.1.1)

**North American Cup Fencing Championship**

**Junior Olympic or Paralympic Rifle Championships**

### DEAD PERIOD

When the dead period for recruiting occurs during the U.S. Diving National Championships, it shall be permissible to observe prospective student-athletes participating in that event.

When the dead period for recruiting occurs during the North American Cup Fencing Championship, it shall be permissible for authorized coaching staff members to observe prospective student-athletes participating in that event.

When the dead period for recruiting occurs during the Junior Olympic or Paralympic Rifle Championships, it shall be permissible for authorized coaching staff members to observe prospective student-athletes participating in the event.

## Recruiting periods defined

### DEAD PERIOD

A dead period is that period of time when it is not permissible to make in-person recruiting contacts or evaluations on or off the member institution's campus or to permit official or unofficial visits by prospective student-athletes to the institution's campus.
