## **ACADEMIC CERTIFICATIONS**

  - ► AICE;
  - International Baccalaureate (IB), (IB-HL), (IB-SL); and
  - Dual or college enrollment courses.
- Core staff would use both Integrated Math III and Algebra II based on the policy above. After entering in all usable courses and credits, we would allow our system to calculate the academic decision.
