NCAA Division III Presidents Council Grouping – Proposal Nos. 2024-1.

The NCAA Division III Presidents Council has identified one proposal of particular interest to Division III chancellors and presidents. This proposal is included in the Presidents Council grouping and will be considered by roll call vote. There are also two related amendments. All motions and votes related to the proposal and amendments must be considered by roll call. Only the Presidents Council may waive this designation and all other motions to change the voting method would be out of order.

2024-1	Roll call vote.	None	<p>A motion to divide the proposal for separate votes would be contrary to the sponsor's intent and would be ruled out of order.</p> <p>Once this proposal is moved and seconded, then one of the sponsors of the amendment-to-amendment No. 2024-1-1 will move it and then it will be seconded. The membership will then debate and vote on whether to amend proposal No. 2024-1 as reflected in No. 2024-1-1. This process is then repeated for No. 2024-1-2. Then the membership will return to No. 2024-1 and debate and vote on the Proposal as either: (1) originally submitted if both amendments are defeated; OR (2) as amended by one or both of the of amendments (2024-1-1 and 2024-1-2) if either or both of the amendments were approved.</p>

NCAA Division III General Grouping – Proposal Nos. 2024-2 through 4.

Additional Notes.

- Effective date: A motion for an alternative effective date on the convention floor would violate the principle of "prior notice" and therefore would be out of order. Alternative effective dates must be noted with the submission of the proposal or offered as an amendment-to-amendment.
- Withdrawing proposals and proposals not moved: The NCAA practice permits sponsors of a proposal to announce their desire to withdraw their proposal from consideration; however, if a single voting delegate objects, the proposal will not be withdrawn. If a published proposal is not moved, the matter is simply passed. An eligible voting member, including the sponsor, may ask for permission later to introduce a proposal that has been passed.
