

Presidents Council Grouping



2026-1: Women's Wrestling

Sponsored by: CCIW, American Rivers & MAC.

- To establish a **Division III** women's wrestling championship starting in 2027-28 academic year; and
- To establish a Division III Women's Wrestling Committee.



2026-2: Use of a Season

Sponsored by: Empire 8, Atlantic East & Little East.

- To specify that a student-athlete would be charged with a season *only* if the student-athlete **competes** at any point during the traditional season.



2026-3: NIL Resolution

Sponsored by: SCIAC & NCAC.

- To ask that Presidents Council charge the governance structure with monitoring the **changing landscape** around Division I NIL and its impact on Division III.
- To ask that the governance structure **develop strategies, policies and if warranted, propose legislative changes** that would protect valid NIL opportunities consistent with the Division III philosophy.



2026-4: In-Region Competition

Sponsored by: SAA, Coast-To-Coast & CCS.

- To **reduce** the required minimum percentage of in-region competition for championships eligibility to **50%** for all sports except golf.
- To **expand** the spring break exception to allow institutions hosting contests during another institution's break to also exempt the out-of-region contest even if that hosting institution is not in an institutional vacation period.



2026-5: Multiple AQ Model

Sponsored by: United East & Presidents Athletic Conference.

- Provide **multiple automatic qualifiers** to multi-sport conferences that have 12 or more members that sponsor a sport.
 - Once a conference reaches 12 or more core members sponsoring a sport, the conference would immediately **receive** a second automatic qualifier.
 - If a conference falls below 12 core members sponsoring a sport, the conference would immediately **lose** their second automatic qualifier.



2026-6: Required Participation for AQ

Sponsored by: SCIAC, Landmark & NCAC.

- Require core members of a conference to **participate in the conference's established AQ process** in that sport to have access to the NCAA Championships.
- If the institution decides to not participate in their conference's AQ process (including declining participation in the conference's postseason tournament) the institution **is not eligible** for NCAA selections, including at-large selections.



General Grouping



2026-7: AQ Waiting Period

Sponsored by: MASCAC, Coast-To-Coast & Conf. of New England.

- To **reduce the waiting period** from two years to one.



2026-8: Mandatory Winter Break

Sponsored by: NACC and CCS.

- Establish a **seven-consecutive-calendar-day-period** break over the winter break.
 - Athletically related activities may **not** occur;
 - Student-athletes may only use facilities open to the general student body;
 - Entire athletics department must agree to same break period; and
 - First required break period would occur in **2028**.



2026-9: NCAA Transfer Portal

Sponsored by: Management Council (ILC).

- **Require use of the NCAA Transfer Portal**, beginning with any student-athletes who request to be entered on or after August 1, 2026.
 - The self-release option would remain **intact**. After the expiration of the self-release, the student-athlete's original institution would be required to enter them into the Portal for recruiting conversations to continue.
 - Require that student-athletes be entered by their original institutions within **seven calendar days** of the request being made.
 - Require that all student-athletes watch an educational module **before** entry.

2026-10: Unofficial Visit Meals

Sponsored by: CCIW & Little East.

- To permit institutions to provide meals in an on-campus dining facility for a prospective student-athlete **and** those individuals accompanying the prospective student-athlete.

2026-11: Practice Expenses

Sponsored by: Management Council (ILC).

- Permit institutions to provide expenses for practice sessions **at any location**, provided:
 - The student-athlete is eligible; and
 - No class is missed.



2026-12: Award Values

Sponsored by: Management Council (ILC).

- Maintain the current limitations on who may give awards to student-athletes and how often awards may be given but **remove the exact \$ amounts** and references to **the value of awards** in the legislation.



2026-13: Post-Eligibility Event Expenses

Sponsored by: Management Council (ILC).

- Permit institutions to provide **actual and necessary expenses** for a student-athlete to participate in one collegiate **all-star contest** or similar post-eligibility event.



2026-14: Professional Sports Tickets

Sponsored by: Management Council (ILC).

- During a team's declared playing season, permit an institution, to provide **professional sports tickets** as reasonable entertainment.
- Maintain the **prohibition** of providing cash for any entertainment.



2026-15: Flag Football for Women

Sponsored by: Management Council (CWA).

- To add women's flag football as an **emerging sport** for women and establish legislation related to playing and practice seasons and membership.



2026-16: Acrobatics & Tumbling

Sponsored by: Management Council (CWA).

- Establish a **National Collegiate Championship** and to establish a women's acrobatics and tumbling committee.



2026-17: Stunt

Sponsored by: Management Council (CWA).

- Establish a **National Collegiate Championship** and to establish a women's stunt committee.

Additional Updates



NC-2026-15: Sports Wagering

- NC-2026-15 was adopted by the Division III Management Council in October.
- Division I rescinded its adoption on November 21, meaning **the rules remain unchanged for everyone.**
- Because the sports wagering rules are **common** across all three divisions, any changes must be adopted by **ALL** divisions.



Playing Rule Exemption

- Management Council has acted to **exempt** Division III from a new playing rule adopted by the Playing Rules Oversight Panel (PROP).
- Beginning with the 2027 season, Women's Lacrosse officials will be **permitted** to use headsets, but the use will **not** be mandatory.
