# **Update #1: Sports Betting/Wagering.**

- NC-2026-15 was adopted by the Division III Management Council in October.
- Because the sports wagering rules are common across all three divisions, any changes must be adopted by ALL divisions.
- Division I rescinded its adoption on November 21, meaning the rules remain unchanged for everyone.




## **Update #2: Playing Rule Exemption.**


- Management Council has acted to exempt Division III from a new playing rule adopted by the Playing Rules Oversight Panel (PROP).
- Beginning with the 2027 season, Women's Lacrosse officials will be permitted to use headsets, but it will not be mandatory.

#### Parts of a Proposal.

INTENT What is the proposal trying to change/fix?

TEXT
 What will: stay, go or be added in?

SOURCE Who thinks this is a good idea?

• **EFFECTIVE DATE** When would the proposal become a rule?

RATIONALE
 Why is this a good idea?



### **How Voting Works.**

- Each active institution and multisport conference, as well as National SAAC, gets one vote.
- If a proposal is adopted, the legislation changes as of the Effective Date.
- If a proposal is defeated, the legislation does not change.

# Women's Wrestling.

Sponsored by: CCIW, American Rivers & MAC.

 To establish a Division III women's wrestling championship starting in 2027-28 academic year; and

• To establish a Division III Women's Wrestling Committee.



#### Use of a Season.

Sponsored by: Empire 8, Atlantic East & Little East.

• To specify that a student-athlete would be charged with a season only if the student-athlete competes at any point during the traditional season.



#### NIL Resolution.

Sponsored by: SCIAC & NCAC.

- To ask that Presidents Council charge the governance structure with monitoring the changing landscape around Division I NIL and its impact on Division III.
- To ask that the governance structure develop strategies, policies and if warranted, propose legislative changes that would protect valid NIL opportunities consistent with the Division III philosophy.



### In-Region Competition.

Sponsored by: SAA, Coast-To-Coast & CCS.

- To **reduce** the required minimum percentage of in-region competition for championships eligibility to 50% for all sports except golf and tennis.
- To **expand** the spring break exception to allow institutions hosting contests during another institution's break to also exempt the out-of-region contest even if that hosting institution is not in an institutional vacation period.



## Multiple AQ Model.

Sponsored by: United East & Presidents Athletic Conf.

- Provide multiple automatic qualifiers to multi-sport conferences that have 12 or more members that sponsor a sport.
  - Once a conference reaches 12 or more core members sponsoring a sport, the conference would immediately receive a second automatic qualifier.
  - o If a conference falls below 12 core members sponsoring a sport, the conference would immediately lose their second automatic qualifier.



### Required Participation for AQ.

Sponsored by: SCIAC, Landmark & NCAC.

- Require core members of a conference to participate in the conference's established AQ process in that sport to have access to the NCAA Championships.
- If the institution decides to not participate in their conference's AQ process (including declining participation in the conference's postseason tournament) the institution is not eligible for NCAA selections, including at-large selections.

# **AQ** Waiting Period.

Sponsored by: MASCAC, Coast-To-Coast & CNE.

To reduce the waiting period from two years to one.



# Mandatory Winter Break.

Sponsored by: NACC & CCS.

- Establish a seven-consecutive-calendar-day-period break over the winter break.
   During the break, student-athletes may not:
  - Be employed at institutional camps and clinics;
  - Participate in any athletically related activities; and
  - Participate in any voluntary athletically related activities on campus unless the facility is open to the general student-body.



#### **NCAA** Transfer Portal.

Sponsored by: Management Council (ILC).

Require use of the NCAA Transfer Portal, beginning with any student-athletes who request to be entered on or after August 1, 2026.

- The self-release option would remain **intact**. After the 30 days of the self-release, the student-athlete's original institution would be required to enter them into the Portal.
- Require that student-athletes be entered by their original institutions within seven calendar days of the request being made.
- Require that all student-athletes watch an educational module before entry.



#### **Unofficial Visit Meals.**

Sponsored by: CCIW & Little East.

 To permit institutions to provide meals in an on-campus dining facility for a prospective student-athlete and those individuals accompanying the prospective student-athlete.



#### **Practice Expenses.**

Sponsored by: Management Council (ILC).

Permit institutions to provide expenses for practice sessions at any location, provided:

- The student-athlete is eligible; and
- No class is missed.



#### Award Values.

Sponsored by: Management Council (ILC).

• Maintain the current limitations on who may give awards to student-athletes and how often awards may be given but remove the exact \$ amounts and references to the value of awards in the legislation.



#### Post-Eligibility Event Expenses.

Sponsored by: Management Council (ILC).

• Permit institutions to provide actual and necessary expenses for a studentathlete to participate in one collegiate all-star contest or similar post-eligibility event.



## **Professional Sports Tickets.**

Sponsored by: Management Council (ILC).

 During a team's declared playing season, permit an institution, to provide professional sports tickets as reasonable entertainment.

• Maintain the **prohibition** of providing cash for any entertainment.



# Flag Football for Women.

Sponsored by: Management Council (CWA).

• To add women's flag football as an **emerging sport** for women and establish legislation related to playing and practice seasons and membership.



### Acrobatics & Tumbling.

Sponsored by: Management Council (CWA).

• Establish a National Collegiate Championship and to establish a women's acrobatics and tumbling committee.



#### Stunt.

Sponsored by: Management Council (CWA).

• Establish a National Collegiate Championship and to establish a women's stunt committee.
