Student-Athlete Reinstatement

When a student-athlete is found to violate an NCAA rule, the violation is resolved by the NCAA student-athlete reinstatement and enforcement staffs. The student-athlete's school reaches out to the NCAA to request reinstatement, which includes a submission of facts by the school. The NCAA reinstatement team then reviews the facts and applies membership committee-developed guidelines and precedent to determine whether a student-athlete should be withheld from competition or have other reinstatement conditions. The process is below:
