



Theodore Roosevelt Award

The “[Teddy](#)” is the highest honor the NCAA may confer on an individual. It is named after President Theodore Roosevelt, whose concern for the conduct of intercollegiate athletics led to the formation of the NCAA in 1906.

The “Teddy” is presented annually to a distinguished citizen of national reputation and outstanding accomplishment. To be eligible, the recipient must have graduated from an NCAA member college or university and earned a varsity athletics award or participated in competitive intercollegiate athletics. Furthermore, the awardee, by personal example and contributions to society, exemplifies the ideals to which collegiate athletics programs are dedicated.

Program Hub Nomination Instructions

Access the Program Hub online nomination system at ncaa.org/programhub.

Please note: Only a campus administrator or coach with a .edu email address can nominate an honoree and submit a nomination form.

- If you are a Single-Source Sign-On User (who has previously logged into LSDBi, RSRO, Compliance Assistant or My Apps), click “Connect Here” under “SSO/NCAA Staff User” and log in with the email and password associated with the SSO account.
- If you are a repeat Program Hub user (without an SSO account), click “Log In” under “Program Hub User” and log in with your email and password.
- If you haven’t used Program Hub before, create a profile as a new user. Click “Create a New Profile” under the “New User?” section.

The NCAA's scholarships, awards and programs now operate out of a centralized system - the NCAA Program Hub - that simplifies our members' interactions with more than 65 educational programs, grants, scholarships, committees and awards.

The system provides a single destination for members to apply or nominate individuals for NCAA programs, such as NCAA Honors and postgraduate scholarships. The Program Hub also makes the application, registration or nomination process more efficient because the single entry point uses previously stored profile information to reduce the data entry required for each program.

1. Once logged in, click the “**Applications**” tab on the navigation bar.
2. Click “Start Registration Application” next to the option that reads “2025 Theodore Roosevelt Award Nomination.”
3. Once on the nominator page, complete the questions.
4. For question 4, download and complete the signature page, then upload it.
NOTE: The signatures of the nominator and athletics director are required to complete the nomination.
5. Click “Save and Continue” at the bottom of the page after completing all questions. You will then be directed to a second page.
6. On the second page, complete all questions and submit all information about the nominee.
7. Once complete, click “Save and Submit.”
8. **Please note: Each school may submit multiple nominations. However, if submitting more than one nomination per category (such as two Theodore Roosevelt Award nominations), each must be entered by a separate Program Hub user on your campus.**
