

Data

- Data were collected from the NCAA Membership Financial Reporting System for fiscal years 2004-05 through 2020-21.
- Significant changes were made to the process beginning with the data collection in 2004-05 (e.g., definitional changes, agreed-upon procedures, etc.), so previous data are not comparable.
- In 2020-21, 302 schools provided data to the NCAA Membership Financial Reporting System.



Generated Revenue Sources


- Ticket sales.

Summary of 2021 Data for Division II Schools With Men's Football


- Large disparities were seen in both revenues and expenses across
 Division II schools with men's football. Expenses ranged from approximately
 \$1.5 million to \$25 million, and total revenue ranged from nearly \$1.3 million
 to \$25 million. The median expenses for this group of institutions was over
 \$6.8 million.
- Generated revenue ranged from \$0 to \$5.5 million. The median generated revenue was approximately \$528,000.
- Generated revenue did not exceed expenses for any school in 2021.
- The median negative net generated revenue was approximately \$6 million. This could be construed as the cost to the school of running a Division II athletics program with football.



Summary of 2021 Data for Division II Schools Without Men's Football

- Large disparities were seen in both revenues and expenses across Division II schools without men's football. Expenses ranged from approximately \$255,000 to \$32.8 million, and total revenue ranged from nearly \$255,000 to nearly \$33 million. The median expenses for this group of schools were \$5.5 million.
- Median generated revenue ranged from \$6,000 to \$3.3 million. The median generated revenue was approximately \$251,000.
- Generated revenue did not exceed expenses for any school in 2021.
- The median negative net generated revenue for Division II schools without men's football was approximately \$5.1 million. This could be construed as the cost to the school of running a Division II athletics program without football.









Revenue and Expense Trends from 2005 to 2021 (by Football Sponsorship)

Division II Median Total Revenue With and Without Football (2005-2021)




Percentage increase from 2005 to 2021:

Division II Median Generated Revenue With and Without Football (2005-2021)




Percentage increase from 2005 to 2021:

Summary of 2005-2021 Trends for Division II Schools With Football

- Over the 17 years studied, median generated revenue grew by 16%. Median total expenses grew by 97%.
- The overall negative net revenue (which might be construed as the "true" cost of running an athletics program) grew from approximately \$2.7 million in 2005 to approximately \$6.0 million in 2021. This represents a change of about 125% over the 17 years studied.



Summary of 2005-2021 Trends for Division II Schools Without Football

- Over the 17 years studied, median generated revenue grew by 30%. Total expenses grew by 131%.
- The overall negative net revenue (which might be construed as the "true" cost of running an athletics program) grew from approximately \$2 million in 2005 to over \$5.1 million in 2021. This represents a change of about 159% over the 17 years studied.









Division II Median Allocated Revenue as a Percentage of Total Revenue With and Without Football (2005-2021)




Division II Median Student Fees as a Percentage of Total Revenue With Football (2005-2021)




Division II Median Contributions as a Percentage of Total Revenue With and Without Football (2005-2021)




Division II Median Athletics Aid as a Percentage of Total Expenses With and Without Football (2005-2021)




Division II Median Coach Compensation as a Percentage of Total Expenses With and Without Football (2005-2021)




Division II Median Administrative Staff Compensation as a Percentage of Total Expenses With and Without Football (2005-2021)




Division II Median Team Travel as a Percentage of Total Expenses With and Without Football (2005-2021)




Division II Median Medical Expenses and Insurance as a Percentage of Total Expenses With and Without Football (2005-2021)




Division II Median Other Additional Expenses as a Percentage of Total Expenses With and Without Football (2005-2021)
