

NCAA Board of Governors Policy on Campus Sexual Violence Annual Attestation – COVID-19 Modifications

For: All NCAA member institutions.

Action: Complete form. Director of Athletics must upload into the NCAA

Learning Portal.

Due date: Due to COVID-19, to be completed not later than **June 15.**

By signing and dating this form, you attest that your institution has satisfied the policy requirements outlined below for the 2019-20 academic year and that you have conferred with your chancellor/president and campus Title IX coordinator prior to signing:

- The athletics department is informed on, integrated in, and compliant with institutional policies and processes regarding sexual violence prevention and proper adjudication and resolution of acts of sexual violence.
- 2. The institutional policies and processes regarding sexual violence prevention and adjudication, and the name and contact information for the campus Title IX coordinator*, are readily available within the department of athletics, and are provided to student-athletes.
- 3. All student-athletes, coaches and staff have been educated each year on sexual violence prevention, intervention and response, to the extent allowable by state law and collective bargaining agreements.

If a school is not able to attest their compliance with the above requirements, it will be prohibited from hosting any NCAA national championship competition for the next applicable academic year.

COVID-19 Modified Directions for Completing the 2019-20 Campus Sexual Violence Attestation Form

Complete the Attestation Form

- 1. Download the 2019-20 modified attestation form.
- 2. After confirming your school has fulfilled the policy requirements and conferring with your university chancellor/president and campus Title IX coordinator, the director of athletics may sign and date the form.
- 3. Scan the completed form to upload.

Director of Athletics' Uploads

- 1. Go to ncaa.org/myapps and select NCAA Learning Portal.
- 2. Click My Courses and launch the 2019-2020 Policy on Campus Sexual Violence Attestation.
 - a. Note: this course is automatically assigned to each director of athletics only.
- 3. Watch the short module video.
- 4. Follow the directions at the end of the video to upload your completed form in the module **by June 15**.

After the form is successfully uploaded, you will receive a confirmation email and the module will be marked as complete.
