

NCAA Board of Governors Policy on Campus Sexual Violence Annual Attestation

For: All NCAA member institutions.

Action: Complete form. Director of Athletics must upload into the NCAA

Learning Portal.

Due date: To be completed not later than **May 15, 2021.**

By signing and dating this form, you attest that your institution has satisfied the <u>policy</u> requirements outlined below for the 2020-21 academic year:

- 1. The athletics department is informed on, integrated in, and compliant with institutional policies and processes regarding sexual violence prevention and proper adjudication and resolution of acts of sexual violence.
- 2. The institutional policies and processes regarding sexual violence prevention and adjudication, and the name and contact information for the campus Title IX coordinator*, are readily available within the department of athletics, and are provided to student-athletes.
- 3. All student-athletes, coaches and staff have been educated each year on sexual violence prevention, intervention and response, to the extent allowable by state law and collective bargaining agreements.

Further, the athletics department will cooperate with college or university investigations into reports and matters related to sexual and interpersonal violence involving student-athletes and athletics department staff in a manner compliant with institutional policies for all students. If a school is not able to attest their compliance with the above requirements, it will be prohibited from hosting any NCAA national championship competition for the next applicable academic year.

Directions for Completing the 2020-21 Campus Sexual Violence Attestation Form

Complete the Attestation Form

- 1. Download the 2020-21 attestation form.
- 2. After confirming your school has fulfilled the policy requirements, have your university chancellor/president, director of athletics and campus Title IX coordinator sign and date the form. Electronic signatures are accepted.
- 3. Scan the completed form for the director of athletics to upload.

Director of Athletics' Uploads Completed Form

- 1. Go to ncaa.org/myapps and select NCAA Learning Portal.
- 2. Click My Courses and launch the 2020-2021 Policy on Campus Sexual Violence Attestation.
 - a. Reminder: this course is automatically assigned to each director of athletics only as the designated individual to complete the module and upload the form.
- 3. Watch the module video.
- 4. Follow the directions at the end of the video to upload your completed form in the module **by May 15**.

After the form is successfully uploaded, you will receive a confirmation email and the module will be marked as complete. NCAA staff will reach out if there are any questions with your form.
